



What are Diversity Circles?

How do we bring people together, across many differences, to work on community opportunities and issues? The Diversity Circles process is grounded in the conviction that, in a democracy, the only successful resolution of such questions and tensions is one that every person actively takes part in. So people are invited to sit down with others from different parts of the community to consider what we hold in common, what keeps us apart, and how we can work together to build a stronger, better place for all of us.

Interested people are invited to convene in diverse discussion circles of 10-12 people over the same 4-6 week period of time. All the circles work on the same issue -- diversity -- and seek insight and solutions for the whole community. At the end of the round of circles, people from all of the groups gather in one place to work together on the action ideas that come out of the circles. .

Each circle meets four times, for two hours each session, supported by two volunteer facilitators who assist the group to work through a provided discussion guide. Circles will meet at sites throughout the Fox Valley. (See schedule inside.) Diversity Circles participation is free of charge and open to any resident of the Fox Cities.
