The Lives of Others Germany, 2006

Rated R

Director: *Florian Henckel von Donnersmarck*

Dreyman, a playwright and his actress companion are big stars in 1984 East Germany. But secretly they are highly critical of the totalitarian regime. Wiesler, a secret service agent is directed to observe the couple. Overheard conversations start to challenge Wiesler's beliefs about his career, his loyalties and life in general.

Fate brings her together with a young writer, Ludovic, after she has an accident outside his basement flat. Ludo ends up helping Mrs. Palfrey by playing a charade - pretending to be her grandson.

A young boy living in a small floating temple learns the ways of The Buddha from an elderly monk. Years later, after experiencing his sexual awakening, he runs away with a girl who has come to the temple to be healed by the master. His lust causes his life to spiral out of control and in the end he returns to the lake temple to find spiritual enlightenment.

May 25 & 26, 2008

The Man without a Past Finland, 2002

Rated PG-13

Director: *Aki Kaurismäki*

The film follows a man who arrives in Helsinki and gets beaten up so severely that he develops amnesia. Unable to remember his name or anything from his past life, he cannot get a job or an apartment, so he starts living on the outskirts of the city and slowly starts putting his life back on track.
